QUALIFICATIONS

AFT 1521 Members who work as true adjunct faculty, that is, teaching as adjunct faculty is your only income, are eligible to apply for Adjunct Faculty Emergency Relief Grant.

- ✓ 60 grants of \$200 each, June, and December of 2024.
- ✓ Grants will go to selected applicants who meet specific criteria described in the grant application.
- ✓ Grants are not intended to compensate anyone for work lost but as a small assistance to help in a difficult situation.

APPLICATION PERIOD

- ✓ First round of grants: April 15 to May 31, 2024
- ✓ Second round of grants: October 15 to November 29, 2024
- ✓ All checks will be delivered or picked up at AFT 1521.
