Major Takeaways from the Survey

Member Participation

- Most members surveyed reported attending at least one **Chapter Meeting** over the past year.
- However, only **22%** of respondents have attended an **Executive Board (E-Board) meeting**, highlighting an opportunity to build more awareness and accessibility around these gatherings. Remember, all members can attend the monthly Executive Board meetings.

Feedback on Events & Services

- A majority of you expressed a desire to **get more involved in committees and causes**. We hear you and we're excited to create more pathways for deeper involvement.
- There's also strong enthusiasm for **more social events**, including:
 - **Happy Hours**
 - **Picnics**
 - **Scholarship Fundraisers**
- These events help us build solidarity and connection beyond the workplace, and we're looking forward to organizing more of them.

Communication and Satisfaction with Guild Services

- The most effective form of communication is Wednesday Wins, followed by Chapter President Emails. The least effective are our social media (Facebook & Instagram)
- Most members reported being **satisfied with the work of the Guild**, and many shared that they **regularly receive helpful support from Guild Representatives**. We're proud of the work our reps do and are committed to continuing to meet your needs.
